Consciousness in Action, 2011 I evaluate two strands of empirical research which have been interpreted to challenge the possibility of causation by conscious intentions One strand draws on experiments on the timing of conscious states this involves original experiments conducted by Benjamin Libet as well as more recent research on neural prediction led by John Dylan Haynes The other line of research is advanced by Daniel Wegner and draws on considerations about the experience of conscious will and cases of dissociations between this experience and actions I propose that neither the timing data nor cases of dissociations provide evidence for the thesis that conscious intentions are causally inefficacious I first sketch a background conceptual framework which I then use to evaluate the claims about conscious intentions based on the above research I propose that the timing experiments do not challenge the efficacy of conscious intentions because the experiments do not address the timing of conscious intentions in the first place In relation to Wegner's claims about the experience of conscious will I propose that cases of dissociation cannot ground a more general claim that this experience is always illusory and that there is no causation by conscious intentions So while I point out that both strands of research face some empirical challenges I propose that the main source of error lies in how the empirical data is interpreted drawing on mistaken assumptions about the nature of intentions and conscious states in general I further propose that there is some empirical research in support of causation by conscious intentions for the future In relation to this I suggest that causation by conscious intentions does not require that conscious intentions immediately precede actions Conscious intentions can be causally efficacious at a temporal distance as well
